We will be going outside a lot so students should be dressed for the weather.

At SHES we have several students with nut allergies. SHES is a nut smart school which means that parents should not knowingly send their child to school with any nut products. If you send your child with a Wow butter sandwich you might want to label it, so that we know it is not peanut butter and is safe for consumption at school. **Just a reminder Nutella contains hazelnuts so it is not permitted at school.**
