## Principal's Message

Welcome and Welcome Back!!!

We hope that everyone had a wonderful summer. We are so excited to get back to school. Over the summer our school has been cleaned from top to bottom and it is sparkling. Our caretaking team did an amazing job. Teachers have all been in getting everything ready for our students to start on Thursday September 7th.

We currently have 23 classes. As children continue to register we continue to place students in classes and work to make sure that they are balanced and the correct size. We will continue to do this even after school begins, so please be patient.

Given the size of our school, we encourage students who can take the bus to do so. School staff, myself and Lisa are outside every morning to greet the students and make sure they make it safely to class. Teachers will make sure that they are on the correct bus in the afternoon. We will be using the Purple Dismissal Tags again this year for Grades P-2, so please make sure you let your child's teacher know where they go after school and what bus they will be taking. #### Being on Time for School

Our school hours are 8:30am to 2:30pm. Students coming by bus arrive between 8:10 am and 8:30am and students arriving by car should also come for the same time. We ask that all students arrive no later than 8:20am. All students should be in their classrooms and ready to start their day at 8:30am.

Students who arrive after this time are late and miss important instructional time in all subject areas, including Physical Education and Music. <u>Children cannot be dropped off or arrive at school before 8:10am. That is the time supervision begins.</u>

We will be going outside a lot so students should be dressed for the weather.

At SHES we have several students with nut allergies. SHES is a nut smart school which means that parents should not knowingly send their child to school with any nut products. If you send your child with a Wow butter sandwich you might want to label it, so that we know it is not peanut butter and is safe for consumption at school. Just a reminder Nutella contains hazelnuts so it is not permitted at school.

2023-2024 is going to be a great year here at SHES!
